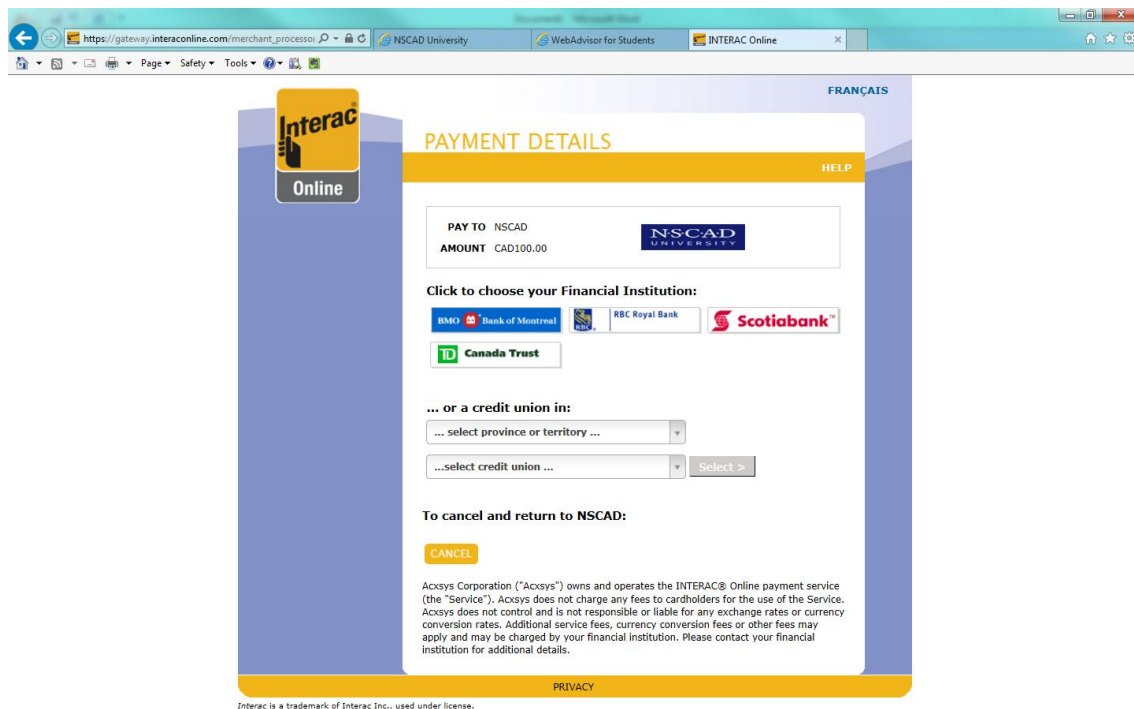
You will see a new link called [Make a Payment](#)
