SUMMER APPROVAL AND PREREQUISITE FORM FOR NON-DEGREE AND VISITING STUDENTS (Mail In Registrations Only)

NON-DEGREE STUDENTS are welcome to register for courses at the Nova Scotia College of Art and Design provided they are eligible for post-secondary study. To qualify as a non-degree student, a person must have successfully completed high school or its equivalent, or qualify for mature student status. Mature student status requires that an individual be at least 22 years of age and have been out of school for at least 5 years.

In order for the Office of Student and Academic Services to determine eligibility to register, Non-degree applicants must submit an "Application for Admission" form, listing all previous secondary and post-secondary studies. Applicants should also be prepared to submit transcripts of secondary and post-secondary studies.

VISITING STUDENTS from another metro area university are welcome to register for courses at the Nova Scotia College of Art and Design to be credited toward their degree programs at their home institution. Visiting students must provide a transcript of their previous studies and an approved Letter of Permission. Visiting Students from the Metro area should see page 5 of the Summer Registration booklet.
