Please bring the following supplies with you:

**Paint:** For this class we will be using Heavy Body Artist Quality Acrylic paint. **Recommended brands:** Golden, Liquitex, or Windsor & Newton Artist Acrylics.

**Alternatives:** Liquitex Basics, Pebeo Studio Acrylics, and DeSerres Student Acrylics. (economic, student

grade paints, but still perform acceptably.)

- Remember, you can always add a new tube of paint to your supplies as needed, working up to a full set.

\* this list represents a full palette with lots of versatility and will allow you to match nearly any colour we'll be working with. If you have colours not on this list bring them along as well – additional options are always helpful!

**Acrylic Glazing Fluid (Gloss).** This is a highly useful product, not essential, but recommended. It is a fluid medium to be mixed with acrylic paint to increase dry time, increase flow, and adjust consistency of the paint. We'll discuss the advantages in class during the first session.

## **Brushes:**

Long Handle Brushes in Stiff Bristle Synthetic or Natural Hog bristle.

(Do not purchase Soft Synthetic and Natural Sable brushes as they are designed for glazing and not suitable for this course.)

Round or Liner size 00 - 0

Flat size 2

Flat size 6

**Optional:** palette knife for mixing colour, and any additional Rounds, Filberts, or other brushes you have for variety.

**Surfaces:** You will need 1 Canvas per class.

16" x 20" Canvases. (your choice of profile/thickness. 1 per class)

One large Canvas (for our final project, dimensions will vary based on choice)

\*Alternates: 16" x 20" Primed/Gessoed Brichwood Panels, or Cradled Wood Panels (your choice of thickness), or Primed/Gessoed MDF Panels. These are all acceptable painting surfaces and we'll discuss the pro/cons of each in class.

## **Other Supplies:**

Drawing pencils, white eraser, sharpener Masking tape Plastic container or glass jar for water Glass or plastic palette Paint rags (or heavy paper towel) Apron

## **Reference Material / Photos:**

For several projects we will be working from photographic source material. These can be photos, digital prints, magazine images, etc. We will discuss in detail what you need to bring during our first class.
