



Dr. Jutta Treviranus is the Director of the Inclusive Design Research Centre (IDRC) and professor at OCAD University in Toronto. She established the IDRC in 1993 as the nexus of a growing global community that proactively works to ensure that our digitally transformed and globally connected society is designed inclusively.

Dr. Treviranus is a Digital Fellow in the Canadian Digital Academy and a member of the Digital Strategy Advisory Panel of Waterfront Toronto. Jutta and her team have pioneered network-supported personalization as an approach to digital accessibility. She also heads the Inclusive Design Institute, a multi-university regional center of expertise (<https://inclusivedesign.ca>). She founded an innovative graduate program in inclusive design at OCAD University, and her work has been attributed as the impetus for corporate adoption of more inclusive practices in large enterprise companies, such as Microsoft.
