



Virtual Summer Student Internship with the Anna Leonowens Gallery

Objective

NSCAD University's Anna Leonowens Gallery will be creating online exhibitions and online courses in July and August 2020. The preparation of these exhibitions and courses will afford a unique opportunity for students to learn, apprentice and apply next wave professional skills, which will greatly enhance their educational experience and potential for participation in the creative digital economy.

The incumbent would be responsible for creating and editing digital content including videos, sound and social media postings. The incumbent would work alongside gallery staff and designers to develop a new platform for online exhibitions and showcases.

The incumbent will also liaise with artists and arts workers in preparing courses for the new Anna Leonowens Professional Development Certificate.

Learning Outcomes

Students will:

- Understand the context of creating digital exhibitions and course design/development.
- Acquire skills and capabilities in technical support of digital curation, including video production, sound, lighting, graphic design, animation and visual presentation.
- Learn to work effectively in multidisciplinary teams, which include academic specialists, instructional designers and technical specialists, through discussion and collaborative development.
- Understand and apply principles and practices of project management.
