The Problem



- Many aspiring artists, designers and makers have great ideas and amazing talents, but don't know how to monetize them.
- Creators experience lost opportunities to create a sustainable financial future for themselves.
- The potential industry and innovation of unsupported creative entrepreneurs is lost to the province's and global social and economic recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic.

- In Canada, creative industries generate \$54.6 billion annually for the Canadian economy.
- The One Nova Scotia report (2014) led Nova Scotia to launch its Culture Action Plan in 2016 which concludes: "We know Nova Scotia's cultural sector is overflowing with creativity and innovation that deserves more recognition, more success, and more support."

Competition & Rationale



- In Nova Scotia there are no start-up or entrepreneurial programs directed specifically to those individuals in the creative economy.
- Because creatives think differently, many lack the confidence to participate in general entrepreneurial and business programs through incubators and continuing education.
- NSCAD has talent pipeline awaiting development through its student and alumni networks, as well as its connections through the arts community.
