

## Winter Student Assistantships in Digital Media Support and Production

### Objective

NSCAD University continues to be highly committed to offering state of the art digital learning through the design and delivery of over 160 winter courses, starting January 2021. These courses will be developed by NSCAD faculty with the assistance of NSCAD staff, instructional designers, and the selected student assistants.

The preparation of these courses will afford a unique opportunity for students to learn, apprentice and apply next wave digital professional skills, which will greatly enhance their educational experience and potential for participation in the creative digital economy. Non-credit courses and workshops will also be offered in the Winter term, which may require the support of Digital Media student assistants.

# **Learning Outcomes**

#### Students will:

- Understand the context of digital learning and course design/development;
- Acquire skills and capabilities in technical support of digital learning, including Brightspace support, video production, sound, lighting, graphic design, animation and visual presentation;
- Learn to work effectively in multidisciplinary teams, which include academic specialists, instructional designers and technical specialists, through discussion and collaborative development

### **Hours of Work**

\$18/hr for 10 hrs/week for 17 weeks in the winter (January 4 - April 30).

#### Student eligibility criteria

As a student (regardless of age), you are eligible for ICTC WIL Digital if you are:

- Registered full-time or part-time in a publicly funded Canadian post-secondary institution in Arts, Humanities, Social Science, Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, or Business Program. (NSCAD)
- A Canadian citizen, permanent resident or a protected person as defined by the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act.
- Legally entitled to work in Canada, including specific province legislation and regulations.
