Do you have documentation of a disability or existence of a medical condition in which you would benefit from accommodation (from registered psychologist, social worker, RCT, psychiatrist, medical doctor or other medical specialist?) A formal diagnosis is not required.

In appropriate situations certain accommodations may be approved on an interim basis for a specific period of time while documentation is pending.
