
Accommodations and Accessibility Support at NSCAD



Do you require Accommodations? You may benefit from Accessibility Services if you: have any impairment (physical, mental, intellectual, cognitive, learning, sensory or functional) that you anticipate affecting your ability to fully and equally participate in your program. Book an appointment with the Accessibility Learning Strategist*. In this appointment:

- The Accessibility Learning Strategist will review documentation with you.
- You will have the opportunity to discuss your accessibility needs, requests for accommodation, and receive support with applying for equipment and service funding.
- The Accessibility Learning Strategist will determine appropriate accommodations and a Letter of Accommodation will be sent to the relevant Instructors and Technicians to be signed and returned to the Accessibility and Accommodations Office.
