#### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

We welcome individuals from all backgrounds to share their academic work and creative projects (including works-in-progress). Students are encouraged to submit <u>academic and creative</u> work on all topics. Participants can also choose to submit work that speaks to our conference theme; however, it is not mandatory that your work align with our theme. This year's theme centers on learning through community and diverse ways of knowing and creating. If you have a project that you would love to share but aren't sure if it fits, please send us your abstract as we are looking to build a highly diverse program of presentations.

Accepted presenters will be invited to give a 12–15-minute presentation during one of the conference panels on March 21 or 22, 2025. We accept abstracts in either French or English.

# **ACADEMIC WORK**

We accept abstracts and project descriptions from all social sciences, humanities, and liberal arts disciplines. Submissions **do not** need to be related to the conference theme/question.

### **CREATIVE WORK**

We highly encourage the showcasing of *creative work\** (visual art, creative writing, multimedia projects, etc.). Film projects and creative writing pieces can be shown or read as part of our conference panels. For visual art, participants can choose to give a presentation about their creative work or simply display their work during the conference.
